



Paper Fold Kite: Pattern & Instructions

1. After drawing the kite dimensions listed on the back of this sheet fold the paper in half.




2. Pull the top layer towards you and make a fold along the pencil line.



3. Turn over. Fold the top piece towards you, so the crease matches the one underneath.




4. Unfold the top piece of paper again, then turn the whole sheet of paper over. Tape and attach dowel as shown.



5. Write your message on the kite.
You can write quotes, short poems, and/or draw images. Then decorate your kite using markers, feathers, etc.



6. Make one tail. Cut the lined piece of paper into strips. Attach the strips using clear tape. Reinforce the end of the tail with tape and hole punch.



7. Attach kite line and tail. Your kite is ready to fly!
